

**IAU College (IAU)** seeks a coordinator/director for its Global Wine Studies Program at its Aix-en-Provence, France campus. The ideal candidate has wine industry experience and broad knowledge of wine production, marketing, sales, and distribution. Masters degree (MBA, Masters in Oenology, etc.) required, PhD preferred. U.S. higher education teaching experience preferred. English fluency required, mastery of French highly recommended.

Responsibilities include teaching 11 wine studies classes per year (seven 3-credit courses and two 1-credit courses) as well as planning and leading field studies and winery visits for students. Examples of classes taught include wine tasting, marketing and analysis, food and wine pairing, international wine trade, and wine production. This position is also responsible for overseeing IAU's wine studies certificate program, cultivating relationships with local and regional wine producers, and coordinating wine tasting events for IAU.
